



## May 18th Term 2, Week 6

Last week Premier Daniel Andrew announced an easing of the current restrictions. He also indicated the return to school dates for Victorian students. Students from **F-2 will return on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> of May**, full time, with the remaining students returning to school on the **9<sup>th</sup> of June**. **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> of May will be a curriculum day** for students so there will be no WebEx sessions or catch ups. All teachers are required to be back on site from this date.

Parents are asked to not congregate on the school grounds at drop off and pick up. We would appreciate everyone abiding by the social distancing regulations. At PFCS we will not be required to have a staggered start at this stage.

If parents choose to keep F-2 students at home from the 26<sup>th</sup> of May, teachers will not be providing work for them. If parents make that decision they will need to create their own set of work for their children.




Buses will run as usual. I will send out, in the next couple of days, a more in-depth letter with more details about our return to school.

On Friday we had a celebration day, called Feel Good Friday. This was designed to give everyone a break from all the screen time and think about how our sense of belonging and community has supported us through this period of isolation. Families were asked to make or decorate the paper doll chains that went home on Xuno. If you haven't got a printer and would like some of these copied or would like some paper to make chains, please message me on Xuno.

To symbolise our sense of belonging to the Port Fairy community and Port Fairy Consolidated School community, families made the chains and then hung them on their fence or in their windows. I received lots of great photos of the finished products. Some of our students gave them to shop owners as a show of support for how hard their businesses have found the isolation period. Please send through any photos that you have. It would be lovely to walk around town and see our chains proudly displayed everywhere!
